Food Preparation Policy: Propane and charcoal grills will be the only permitted means of food preparation, and hot coals must be completely extinguished with water before leaving the tailgating site. No food is to be sold. Security and Health Support: The staff of Paul Quinn College is making every effort to keep our students and visitors safe and healthy during Homecoming. Medical and security personal will be present throughout the day. If you find yourself in need of security or health support, please call the main security booth at (214) 379-5599. If you have an emergency situation, please call 911. Release of Liability: Visitors voluntarily assume all risk of personal injury incidental to the Homecoming event, including the risk of lost, stolen or damaged property. The college may revoke a parking license or visitor status and eject or refuse entry to anyone it deems in violation of venue rules, illegal activity, misconduct or failure to comply with any and all security measures. This release applies to the signer and all of your guests. Vendors: No vendors are permitted to sell PQC paraphernalia without prior approval from the college. Third-Party Entertainment: All third-party entertainment (including, but not limited to, artists and performers, party/game busses, inflatable gaming, etc.) will need prior approval from the college to enter campus. **COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements:** All visitors and event guests over 12 years of age must be fully vaccinated prior to arrival on campus. Each individual attending Homecoming will be required to upload their vaccination record in the Quinnite Health Check portal. This should be done prior to arriving on campus for quick and easy access. Once the vaccine record is uploaded and accepted, each individual will receive a confirmation that should be shown at the entry gate for access. Those who show up at the gate without previously having completed the online submission may bring a hardcopy of their COVID Vaccine card and show this at the main entry gate. Those who are not cleared and/or do not submit a proof of being fully vaccinated will not be permitted to enter campus.
